

COMMUNITY TRAVEL AMBASSADOR PROGRAM

The Travel Ambassador "train-the-trainer" program is designed to give an in-depth overview of travel options available in the Puget Sound region.

The Community Travel Ambassador program enables you to become familiar with programs services, tools and agencies involved in providing transportation. You will also be given in-depth information on methods to ensure safe travel for individuals you are assisting.



When you participate in the Community Travel Ambassador training you will be given the knowledge and resources that will enable you to evaluate the best travel choices for individuals. The 3 hour comprehensive training highlights information related to numerous travel options available in the region including Transit, Light Rail, Ferry, Taxi and Community Transportation

In addition, you will learn about several trip planning tools, bus schedules, available permit & pass options, service animals and mobility devices rules and rights.

Community Travel Ambassadors will be provided with a complementary transportation reference manual, service brochures, forms, surveys and on-going support that will enable you to keep up to date as programs and transportation options change.

Volunteering as a Community Travel Ambassador requires a *6 month* commitment.
